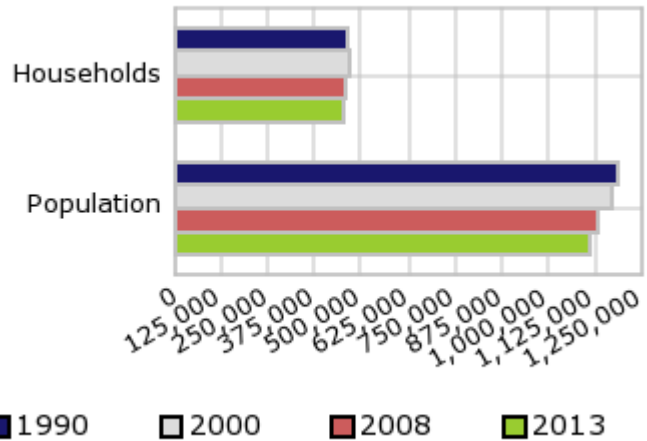
Executive Summary Report with Charts

Population Demographics

The number of households in the study area in 1990 was **461,799** and changed to **468,717** in 2000, representing a change of **1.5%**. The household count in 2008 was **457,038** and the household projection for 2013 is **450,330**, a change of **-1.5%**.

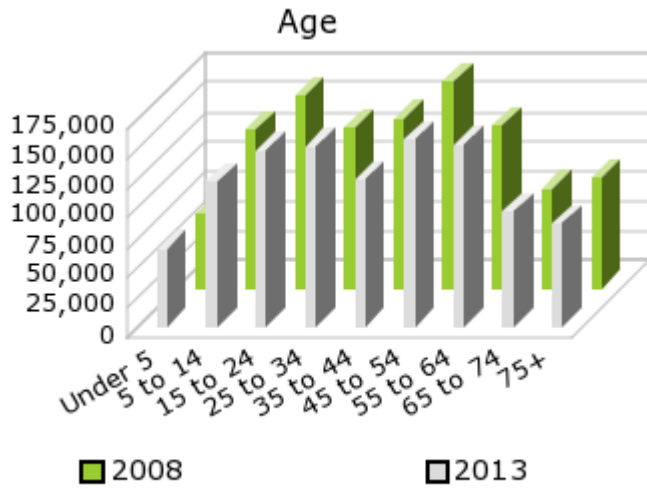
The population in the study area in 1990 was **1,189,284** and in 2000 it was **1,170,105**, roughly a **-1.6%** change. The population in 2008 was **1,133,142** and the projection for 2013 is **1,111,971** representing a change of **-1.9%**.

Population by Age



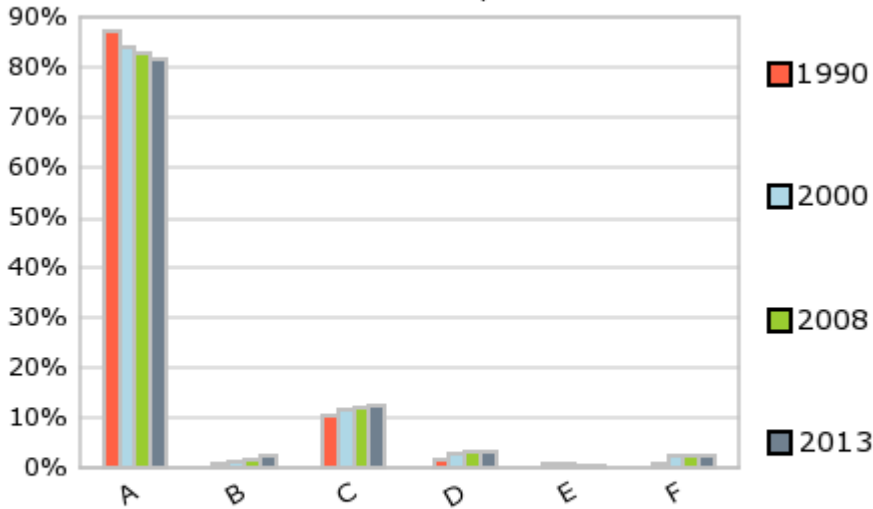
In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **34.7**, and in 2000, it was **38.0**. The median age in 2008 is **40.0** and it is predicted to change in five years to **40.4** years. In 2008, females represented **51.9%** of the population with a median age of **41.9** and males represented **48.1%** of the population with a median age of **38.0** years. In 2008, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 45 to 54** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **0 to 4** years.

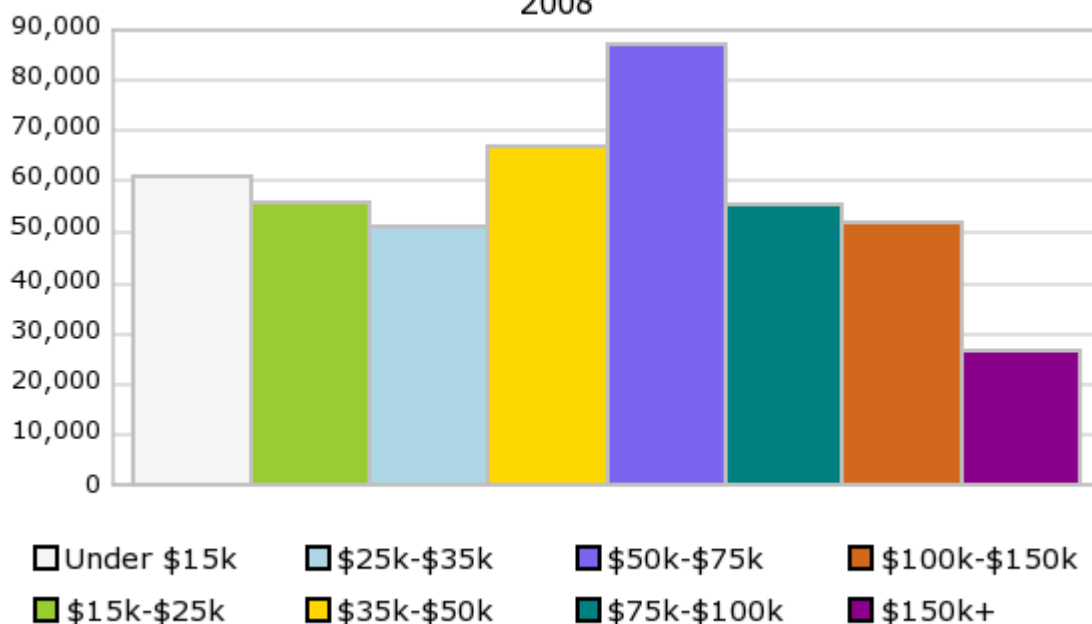
