There will be approximately 200 guest rooms, a restaurant, conference room, fitness room, and a rooftop bar. Construction will be limited to interior renovations and preservation of the historic exterior.

The Sanborn Distillery plant will be able to process 15 tons of feedstock per day, produce 250,000 liters of consumable alcohol and 1 million liters of denatured ethanol per year. All raw materials will be processed at the Sanborn facility then shipped to the Hyde. Park facility, that will focus on bottling and distribution.

Empire Emergency provides highly customized response vehicles for police, fire and municipal uses. Due to significant growth in business, Empire needs to construct an approximately 9,700 square foot addition to its current facility. The project will entail the addition of production bays and the rearrangement of parts warehousing and the shipping department. Additional space for fire apparatus manufacturing and law enforcement vehicle manufacturing will be added.
