Richard Soluri: Richard Soluri, Lewiston, New York, representing the Niagara Falls Center for Tourism added some information relative to the project, including the fact that the building tourism aspects of this project will be extremely high tech, including the 4D theaters. Also, in addition to the jobs that will be created by this tourism project, the building already supports 12 vendors and additional non-seasonal employment at Cataract Travel. The owners intend to work diligently to fill the entire building, with the expectation that this will spur significant new development. There is another large project in the works, but it is premature to discuss that at this time.
