Comments can be in support of, or in opposition to, or on the nature or location of the project. All comments are to be limited to this project only.

The Agency has previously provided financial assistance (the "Financial Assistance") to the Company for qualifying portions of the Project, consisting of partial real property tax abatement in the form of a certain Payment-In-Lieu-Of-Tax agreement (the "Existing PILOT").

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Pursuant to the Company's request to extend the term of the existing PILOT, the Agency will consider acquiring or retaining title to, or a leasehold interest in, the Facility and lease the Facility back to the Company. The Company will operate the Facility during the term of the lease. At the end of the lease term, the Company will purchase the Facility from the Agency, or if the Agency holds a leasehold interest, the leasehold interest will be terminated. The Agency contemplates that it will provide financial assistance (the "Financial Assistance") to the Company for qualifying portions of the Project, consisting of an extension of the Existing PILOT between the Agency and the Company.

conversion to natural gas at Dunkirk, which is kind
