The Company was formed in 2012 as a result of the bankruptcy proceeding of the predecessor in interest. At that time, the Agency and the Company entered into a PILOT Agreement which was subsequently amended and restated in 2016. The PILOT Agreement was necessary for the Company to operate the Facility in an economical manner and retain employment within Niagara County. The PILOT Agreement expires on December 31, 2018 and if the Company is forced to pay unknown, excessive taxes, it may be forced to reduce current employment levels or, worse, cease its operations. The Company is seeking an extension of the existing PILOT Agreement for an additional two (2) years.				
In 2016, the Company obtained a loan in the amount of \$25,000,000 from MUFG Union Bank, N.A., which loan is secured by a Mortgage, Security Agreement, Assignment of Leases and Rents, and Fixture Filing, dated September 1, 2016 (the "Mortgage"). Due to the Agency's leasehold interest in the Property, the Agency authorized the Executive Director to sign the Mortgage.				
The Company is currently in discussions with the lender to increase the loan amount which will be secured by one or more revised mortgages on the Property, which will be required to be executed by the Company and the Agency. The increased mortgage amount does not exceed what was previously authorized by the Agency, therefore no additional benefits are being sought as part of this request. However, the Agency, through its counsel, will need to review the revised mortgage(s) documents to confirm that no additional benefits have been conferred and that the revised mortgage(s) is materially consistent with the prior mortgage documents. Accordingly, the Company hereby respectfully requests that the Agency authorize its appropriate officers, employees and agents to execute one or more revised mortgages in an amount not to exceed what was previously authorized by the Agency. The form of the revised mortgage(s) is still being finalized. A draft will be circulated to the Agency's counsel for review as soon as it is available.
