Significant parts of the second floor (30,000 sq. ft.) need demolition and renovation and all or parts of the third floor of up to 100,000 sq. ft. need renovation. With these improvements, a new parking lot needs to be added to accommodate the new employees.

During the past several years, we have updated parts of the complex and have attracted several long term tenants. Continued renovations are need not only to retain those existing tenants, but to allow us to attract new tenants. The Agency's help will allow us to move forward.
