OLIN CORPORATION, for itself or on behalf of an entity formed or to be formed (the "Company"), has submitted an application (the "Application") to the Agency, a copy of which is on file at the office of the Agency, requesting that the Agency consider undertaking a project (the "Project") for the benefit of the Company consisting of: (A) the acquisition or retention of a fee or leasehold interest in an approximately .8-acre parcel of land presently known as 2725 Buffalo Avenue in the City of Niagara Falls, New York (the "Land"); (B) the the construction on the Land of four new manufacturing buildings consisting in the aggregate of 9,640 square feet (the "Improvements"); and (C) the acquisition and installation of related machinery, equipment and personal property (the "Equipment" and, together with the Land, the Existing Improvements and the Improvements, the "Facility"); (D) the leasing of the Project back to the Company, and (E) the providing of financial assistance to the Company for qualifying portions of the Project in the form of sales and use tax exemptions and a mortgage recording tax exemption, consistent with the policies of the Agency, a partial real property tax abatement and a mortgage recording tax exemption with respect to a certain payment-in-lieu-of-tax mortgage.

The Agency will acquire or retain title to, or a leasehold interest in, the Facility and lease the Facility back to the Company. The Company will operate the Facility during the term of the lease. At the end of the lease term, the Company will purchase the Facility from the Agency, or if the Agency holds a leasehold interest, the leasehold interest will be terminated. The Agency contemplates that it will provide financial assistance (the "Financial Assistance") to the Company for qualifying portions of the Project in the form of sales and use tax exemptions and a mortgage recording tax exemption for financing related to the Project, consistent with the policies of the Agency, a partial real property tax abatement and a mortgage recording tax exemption with respect to a certain payment-in-lieu-of-tax agreement mortgage.
