Description: 160 East Avenue, LLC was established to redevelop an abandoned medical

office building in the City of Lockport. Shareholders of the company include Dr. Jeffrey Schratz, Dr. Robert Hodge and Susan Lougen, all of Great Lakes Surgical

Associates.

When renovated, the building will be a state-of-the-art medical center that will provide services not currently available in Niagara County. Great Lakes Surgical Associates will be the anchor tenant and occupy 3,000 square feet. The remainder of the building will consist of a 4-unit ambulatory surgery center to be used by Eye, ENT, Gastroenterology, and Orthopedic sub-specialists. This ambulatory center will provide residents of Niagara County an alternative and convenient location for their surgical procedures. Ambulatory Surgery Centers provide shortened waiting times, reduce the possibility of infection and reduce the cost of health care. Currently, the closest ambulatory center is 20 miles

away in Erie County.
