	The Lake Street building is a former cold storage that will be renovated to accommodate the brewery and pub, as well as additional space to be leased to other retail tenants. Woodcock Brothers Brewing Company Inc. will be a full production craft beer brewery, serving a wood fired menu in a 40 seat bar and 40 seat dining room along with a 40+ seat patio for use in summer months. The brewery will be the first producing beer on premises in Niagara County and it will help to enhance Wilson as a tourism destination.
