Description: Merritt Plywood Machinery, Inc. (Merritt PMI) is a manufacturer of

machinery for the production of wood veneer and plywood. Merritt's roots can be traced back to the 19th century, with the founding of a small machine shop in Lockport. The current owner purchased the company in 1977 and, over the years, developed new products and grew the company. Merritt expanded its Lockport facility in 2000, with the

assistance of a PILOT through the NCIDA.

The owner of Merritt PMI is now retiring. In order to forestall the potential closure of the facility and the cessation of operations in Lockport, the Controller of Merritt PMI has formed a new company, Merritt Machinery, LLC to purchase the assets of Merritt PMI. In order to remain competitive in the marketplace, the company is requesting the assumption of the

current PILOT, and an extension through 2023.
