8.1 Wheatfield Business Park/Moog Inc.

Ms. Langdon stated that the company designs, assembles and tests small thrusters, components and systems for space propulsion. The hardware is made and tested at the Wheatfield facility on Walmore Road. The company is requesting a 15 year property tax abatement and sales tax abatements. There are 50 full time existing jobs with plans to hire 25 more employees within 3 years. Tom Klementowski attended the Board Meeting and gave a brief description of the project.

This economic development fund has been established by Senator Ortt and will target projects that will be located within a one to two mile radius around the Seneca Casino.

Funding applications will be reviewed by a Committee which will be appointed. Upon recommendation of the Committee, applications must be approved by the NCIDA Board.
