7.1 460 Wheatfield Street, LLC

The project will bring the building back to life by converting the interior to thirty-seven (37) apartments. The company is requesting a fifteen (15) year property tax abatement and sales and mortgage recording tax abatements.

The Public Hearing was held on May 2, 2018 with four (4) speakers, some were in favor of the project and others just wanted clarification of market rate housing vs. subsidized housing. The apartments will be at market rate and not subsidized.
