5.0 Approval of NCIDA Meeting Minutes

5.1 Meeting Minutes of August 8, 2018

Mr. McCabe stated that he had reviewed the meeting minutes and he made a motion to approve them; Mr. Ross seconded the motion. The motion passed.

6.0 Finance & Audit Committee Reports

6.1 Agency Payables

Mr. McCabe stated that he had reviewed the monthly payables and found them to be in order.

7.0 Unfinished Business

7.1 Metropolis Properties Management

The company is requesting a 10 year PILOT on their project of acquiring and renovating a 114,000 square foot building on 6th Street in Niagara Falls. The public hearing was held on September 4, 2018 with six (6) attendees and two (2) speakers. Mr. Ross stated that he attended the Public Hearing and he feels that the project will attract international visitors that otherwise would stay in Canada.

The building will be converted into a four (4) star hotel with approximately 200 guest rooms and a restaurant, fitness room, rooftop bar & conference room. Construction will be limited to interior renovations and preservation of the historic exterior.

Mr. Gabriele stated the project can be a "retail exception" due to the fact that it is located in a distressed area with a high poverty rate and a high unemployment rate.

Fifty-two (52) new jobs will be created inclusive of management, supervisors, food and beverage service, housekeeping, and maintenance.

8.0 New Business

8.1 ANAT Liquor Factory

The company intends to purchase and renovate a building on Hyde Park to be utilized in conjunction with the company's Sanborn site for distillation, bottling and distribution of Anat brand spirits. All raw materials will be processed at the Sanborn facility and the final product will be shipped to the Hyde Park facility for bottling and distribution. It was previously expected that the entire operation would be conducted out of the new building in Sanborn, but due to operational needs and the growing scope of the project, it will be more efficient for the company to utilize the dual facility strategy.

The company is requesting a fifteen (15) year property tax abatement along with sales tax and mortgage recording tax abatements toward the purchase and renovation of the building. Fifteen (15) new jobs will be created at the Hyde Park Facility and nine (at) the Sanborn location.

Steve Walters, a representative of the company, gave a summarization of the project and described the need for both locations. Phase I will be the renovations to the Hyde Park facility and the new construction in Sanborn, and Phase II will include construction of a tasting room which the company hopes will become a tourist attraction to both the local people and visitors.
