All bids will be publicly opened and read in the Board Room of said offices on July 7, 2025 at 10:00 a.m.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

NIAGARA INDUSTRIAL INCUBATOR COMPANY ("NIIC") is soliciting sealed bids from qualified contractors for the construction of an interior wall at the facility located at 2055 Niagara Falls Boulevard, Niagara Falls, NY 14304. Bids are to be opened and read publicly at the offices of NIIC, 6311 Inducon Corporate Drive, Suite One, Sanborn, New York 14132 on July 7, 2025 at 10:00 a.m.

All bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope clearly marked as to the contents therein, bearing on the outside the name and address of the vendor. If sent by mail, the sealed envelope containing the bid must be enclosed in another envelope labeled as specified and is to be sent to the attention of Mike Dudley.

In case of inability to make delivery on account of strikes, governmental priorities or rules and regulations, the bidder, upon written notification to NIIC, may extend such delivery date.

All bids must be accompanied by a non-collusion statement in order to be considered.

NIIC reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive informalities with respect thereto.

Bidders shall read thoroughly and understand the specifications and bid conditions contained herein.

No fax or verbal bids will be accepted. Bidders are responsible for the timely delivery of bid packages to NIIC.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

- 1. <u>CHANGES AND EXTRAS</u> The NIIC may at any time by a written order make changes within the general scope of this contract. If any such change causes an increase or decrease in the cost or time required for the performance of this contract, then an equitable adjustment shall be made in the contract price. Such cost may be adjusted in writing only, and must be signed by both contractor and NIIC. Likewise, any claim for extra charges by the contractor must be agreed upon in writing by the NIIC prior to beginning such work.
- 2. <u>SALES TAX</u> NIIC is exempt from paying any State and Local sales tax. Vendors shall not include any such taxes in their bids. Exemption certificates will be furnished upon request.
- 3. <u>SITE VISITS</u> Bidders are encouraged to visit and inspect the site prior to submitting their bid.
- 4. <u>SAFETY</u> The successful bidder shall protect the tenants and general public while performing such work.
- 5. **PREVAILING RATE OF WAGES** The successful bidder will be required to pay each laborer, workman or mechanic employed by the contractor or subcontractor not less than the New York State Department of Labor prevailing rate of wages.
- 6. <u>**CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY</u></u> These specifications shall not be construed as placing the work under the specific direction or control of NIIC or relieving the contractor from liability as an independent contractor and, as such, the contractor shall be solely responsible for the method, manner and means by which the work shall be performed, including, but not limited to supervision and control of their employed personnel and</u>**

scheduling of the work required to insure proper and timely performance and shall exercise due care to prevent bodily injury and damage to property in the prosecution of the work required.

- 7. **PROSECUTION OF WORK** The contractor shall give personal attention to the work while in progress and shall provide competent reliable employees at all times. Any discrepancies or questions pertaining to the extent of the work shall be submitted immediately to Mike Dudley, Project Manager. If the contractor fails to begin the work within the time specified, or fails to perform the work with adequacy or performs the work unsuitable or does not carry the work in an acceptable manner, the NIIC shall give notice in writing to the contractor of such and the NIIC shall have full power and authority without violating contract to terminate the agreement.
- 8. <u>**PAYMENT**</u> The contractor shall furnish to the NIIC a complete itemized bill. The NIIC will make payment within thirty (30) days after the completion of the work.
- 9. <u>WORKING CONDITION</u> The contractor shall not leave equipment on site without approval of the NIIC. The contractor shall be responsible for any damages to the NIIC property. The contractor shall secure the work site against possible injury or harm to others.
- 10. <u>SCHEDULE COORDINATION</u> All work will be coordinated with the Property Manager.

11. SPECIFICATIONS

Specification for Interior Wall Construction at 2055 Niagara Falls Blvd.

- 1. Wall at Main entrance. One wall east side approximately 9' x 14'. Metal studs 3-5/8". 5/8" drywall both sides, insulate with R15, tape and finish. Ready for paint.
- 2. Wall at Main entrance. One wall west side approximately 9' x 14' metal studs 3-5/8". 5/8" drywall both sides, insulate with R15, tape and finish. Ready for paint.

- 3. Close off hallway east side metal studs up to grid ceiling 3-5/8" drywall both sides, insulate with R15, tape and finish. Ready for paint.
- 4. Remove 2 doors in new office. Remove metal jambs, install studs and drywall, insulate with R15 to match existing.
- 5. Construct new wall in warehouse approximately 37' x 21'. 3-5/8" metal studs 16" on center with wall stiffeners. Double 5/8" fire code drywall both sides. Drywall to extend to roof deck. Match existing wall. Install fire tape and compound on warehouse wall only. Level #2. Wrap metal column with double 5/8" fire code drywall to match existing. Fire caulk all penetrations as required. Contractor will cover all existing carpet with floor protector. Contractor will remove debris and broom sweep floors. Insulate walls with R15

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS - The successful bidder shall furnish the NIIC certificates of insurance indicating the type, amount, class of operations, coverage effective dates and expiration dates of such policies. Such certificates shall also contain substantially the following statement. "The insurance covered by this certificate will not be cancelled or materially altered except (a) after ten (10) days written notice has been received by Niagara Industrial Incubator Company and (b) the Unlimited Indemnity shown in the contract documents is included." NIIC shall be named as "additional insured".
